

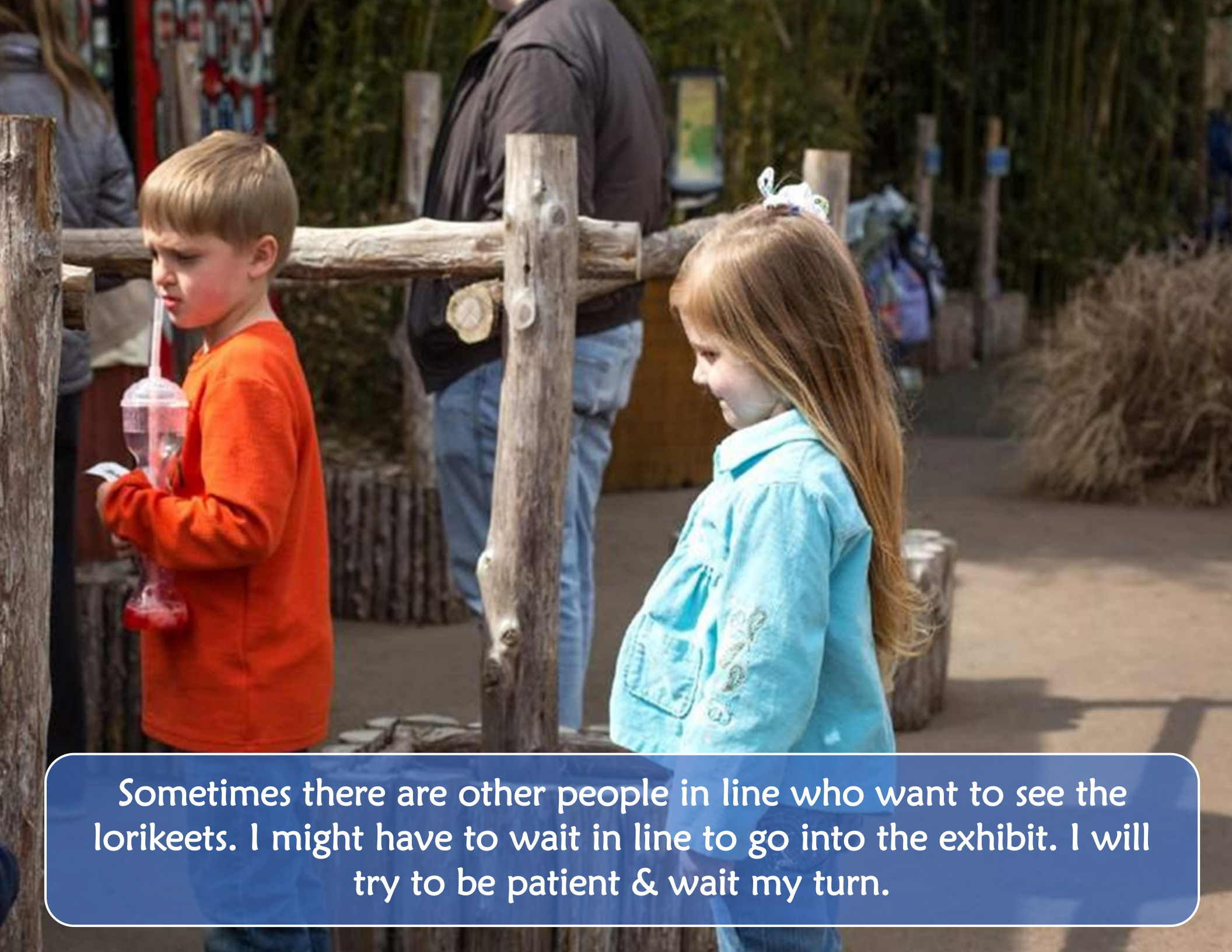
Lorikeet Landing

I am going to the Lorikeet Landing exhibit at the zoo!



Sometimes there are other people in line who want to see the lorikeets. I might have to wait in line to go into the exhibit. I will try to be patient & wait my turn.

A zoo worker will let me know when it is my turn. They will tell us the rules before we go in. I will try to listen carefully & be quiet while the zoo worker is talking.



The zoo worker might give me a small cup of nectar to feed the lorikeets. I do not have to feed the lorikeets if I do not want to. If I do not want the cup, I might say “no thank you”.





The zoo worker will tell me when I can go into the exhibit. Inside the exhibit, there will be lots of lorikeets. It might be very loud. I might be excited & I might be a little nervous That is okay!



A lorikeet might land on me. That is okay! The lorikeets will not hurt me & it might tickle a little. If I want the lorikeet off of me, I can ask the zoo worker to help.



I will try to stay calm & quiet in the exhibit. I will try to walk & talk softly so that I do not startle the lorikeets. If I would like to leave the exhibit, I can let my family know.
